



## What is the Comprehensive Plan?

The City of Montrose is undertaking a community engagement process to develop the City of Montrose Comprehensive Plan (Plan). The purpose of the Plan is to establish a community vision, set goals, and identify opportunities for growth and development with a 20-year vision and 10-year focus. The Plan serves as the City's official guide for local decision-making on long-range planning, land use, development, policy, and capital improvements.

The Comprehensive Plan covers the primary areas of community planning and development, including land use and growth, transportation and mobility, housing, parks, trails and open space, recreation and tourism, and more. It provides a background of existing conditions, describes the vision, goals and objectives of the community, and includes an implementation plan.

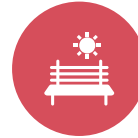
